

Mathematics 2021

There are three different courses that students' can be enrolled in for Mathematics namely:

- 5.3
- 5.2 and
- 5.1

All three courses do the same core work, however, the 5.2 Mathematics course does additional units of study in comparison to the 5.1 Mathematics course and the 5.3 Mathematics course does additional **extension** units of study in comparison to the 5.2 and 5.1 Mathematics courses.

At Kellyville High School the Mathematics faculty runs our courses so that levels overlap one another.

Over the two year course, ongoing assessment of students' progress will be made and if deemed appropriate a change of course may be made in order to best meet students' needs.

ROSA Grades?


Unlike all other courses studied at a Stage 5 level which have the grading scales from A to E, Mathematics have 9 grading scales namely: A10, A9, B8, B7, C6, C5, D4, D3 and E2.

ROSA Grades?

For ROSA purposes the entire year group will be analysed as a whole and allocated these grades at the end of their Stage 5 Mathematics course.

ROSA Grades?

The nature of this criteria and the varying levels of study in Mathematics, means that potentially only the students' that have studied the 5.3 course could achieve the top grades as per the given ROSA grading criteria and the 5.2 and 5.1 students' would have an upper limit on the grades that they could achieve.
