PARENT COMMUNICATION

Dear Kellyville High School Community

As you are no doubt aware the Prime Minister and Premier have provided recent updates regarding school operations. This morning the NSW Premier has announced that schools will remain open but parents are encouraged to keep their students at home and that schools will move to remote teaching and learning until the end of term. Kellyville High School will be following the NSW Governments advice.

Students will be briefed today regarding remote learning and will be encouraged to take home required learning materials ready for remote teaching and learning. Staff will also be sending out information to parents via the parent portal giving details regarding remote mode for students.

Kellyville High School is committed to supporting children of families who are providing essential services and will be providing supervision for these students at school. These students would be doing remote learning on the school premises. I have been told that Hillsbus will still be operational for school bus runs at this point of time.

We have been notified by our Canteen Provider that today will be the last day that the canteen will be operational. This means that any student who is on the premises will need to have with them all their food and drinks for the day.

Our remote teaching and learning mode is designed to simulate a normal school day. Students who are well are strongly encouraged to have as normal a school routine as possible: getting up in the morning, having breakfast and commencing learning for the day, following their school timetable for the day. Teachers will be online throughout the day leading students through activities, asking and answering questions, requesting work and providing feedback.

We are certainly navigating unchartered waters, I am, however, confident that as we will be able to provide an ongoing teaching and learning environment.
