YEARS 7 & 9 - WEEKS 7-9 | TERM 1

NAPLAN is an annual nationwide assessment for students in Years 7 and 9, testing their skills in reading, writing, language conventions, and numeracy. It helps parents, teachers, and schools understand students' progress and identify areas for improvement, providing valuable insights alongside other assessments. While NAPLAN is not a measure of overall school quality, its results support monitoring educational approaches and ensuring students develop essential foundational skills.

TEST DOMAINS:

WRITING 42 MINS



Students are provided with an idea or topic called a writing stimulus (or prompt) and asked to write a response in a particular genre (narrative or persuasive writing).

READING 65 MINS



Students read a range of informative, imaginative and persuasive texts, and then answer related questions.

Students are assessed on spelling, grammar and punctuation.

NUMERACY 65 MINS



Students are assessed on number and algebra, measurement and geometry, and statistics and probability.
